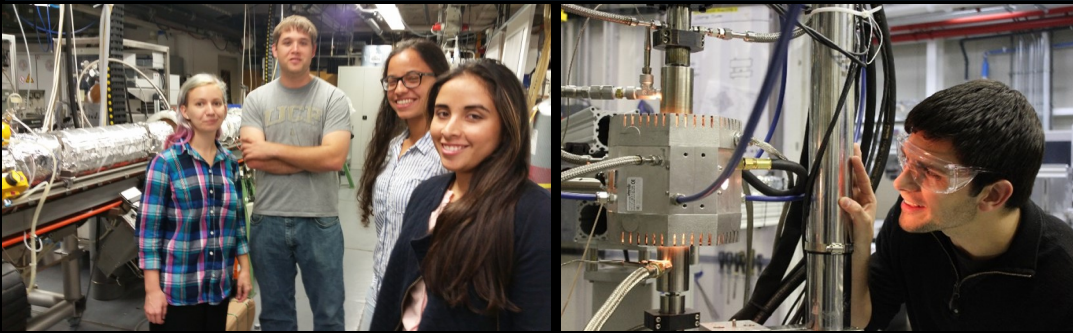


International Research Experience for Students
